**Title:** Resident Camp Health Supervisor/Nurse

**Summary of Position:** To supervise general health and safety of campers and staff at resident camp

**Duration of position:** 1 week or 2 weeks available, Thursday-Thursday

### **Job responsibilities:**

As Health Supervisor/Nurse, you will administer first aid and care in cases of illness and accident, maintain health center hours for scheduled medications and other treatment, and collect, review and keep health records and prepare and maintain reports.

Additional responsibilities include:

- Maintains first aid kits for units, waterfront, vehicles, and key locations in camp.
- Initiates health education and safety practices; maintains health emergency procedures.
- Checks incoming campers for existing illnesses and health conditions.
- Notifies Camp Director of serious illness, accident or unusual situations.
- Supervises sanitation and safety practices throughout the entire camp.
- Maintains health center and its equipment in clean, ready to use condition at all times.
- Maintains contact with physician and hospital after consultation with the Camp Director.
- Requisitions necessary equipment and supplies.

### **Job requirements:**

Our Health Supervisor/Nurse, will need to have experience in making decisions and acting wisely in emergencies, as well as being able to stimulate interest in health and safety practices.

Health Supervisor/Nurse qualifications:

- Have current New York State RN Certification.
- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Have first aid training.
- Have a current driver's license.
