Session 1 | 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Emergency Care: What the School Nurse Needs to know!*Presenter: Olga Jeanne Dolly MSN, FNP-C, RN, BSed, SNT*

This session will examine some of the most frequently encountered emergencies in school. We will cover Mass Casualty Triage, Bleeding, and Impaled Objects. Review use of Combat Tourniquet, Israel Dressings, Hemostatic Dressings, and Chest Seal Dressings. We will discuss emergency plans for Epilepsy, Anaphylaxis, and Concussions. Review assessment skills in Neurology, Cardiac, Abdominal, and C-Spine. You will receive training in Narcan use. This session will review the latest “Managing Emergency Health Care and Communicable Diseases in the School Setting” November 2022 NYSED Guidelines.

By the end of this session, participants will be able to:

- Identify and treat bleeding emergencies
- Identify the four Mass Casualty Triage Categories
- Identify three signs and symptoms of a serious injury
- Discuss at least three emergency plans
- Review four assessment skills

O. Jeanne has 20 years of school nurse experience. She went on to receive her Family Nurse Practitioner from Upstate Medical University and has served as Medical Director for Indian River Central School District for 10 years. Emergency Supplies—Being prepared for emergencies*Presenter: Constance Griffin BSN, RN, NCSN, AC-E*

This session will examine both emergency plans and supplies needed. You will learn what is needed to be prepared for an emergency. Identify what is required by New York State Education Department (NYSED). We will review multiple different kinds of emergency first aid kits.

By the end of this session, participants will be able to:

- Identify three different kinds of first aid kits
- Discuss criteria for three different emergency plans
- Identify at least three requirements for emergencies by NYSED

Connie has been a school nurse in the Valley Central School District for 29 years and is currently also the district school nurse coordinator of 10 RN's and six LPN's in a district of 4100 students. She holds national certifications as a School Nurse (NCSN) and as

an Asthma Educator (AE-C). Connie has been a member of NYSASN since 1995 and has served on the NYSASN Board of Directors since 1996, and the SNO Faculty since 2004. She has served two four-year terms on the NASN Board of Directors. She has received the Judith Harrington Founder's Award (2012), Excellence in School Nurse Award (2010), Affiliate School Nurse of the Year Award (2013), and has held multiple positions on the board of NYSASN; Zone 5 Representative, Promotions Chair, Communication Liaison, NASN Director, and President. Connie also serves on the advisory board to the NASN publication "NASN School Nurse" and the advisory board of the Orange County Medical Reserve Corps.

Session 3 | 2:30-3:30 p.m. **Orthopedics for School Nurses**

Presenter: Oswaldo A. Luciano MSN, MS, NCSN, NPD-BC, MED SURG-BC, RN

This session will examine some of the most frequent orthopedic injuries that may occur in a school setting and provide advice on how to handle them.

By the end of the session, participants will be able to:

- Identify and treat soft tissue injuries.
- Treat and identify strains and sprains.
- Identify at least two different causes of limping
- Discern symptoms of a dislocation and when to seek medical care.
- List 3 different types of fractures and their interventions.

Oswaldo A. Luciano is a Registered Nurse in New York City. He is the Prep School Nurse at Columbia Grammar & Preparatory School. He also serves as a Clinical Program Manager in Nursing Education and Professional Development at the Mount Sinai Hospital, and an adjunct faculty at the Phillips School of Nursing of Mount Sinai Beth Israel. He received his MSN in Nursing Education from Stony Brook University, and he holds national certifications as a School Nurse, Nurse Professional Development, and Medical-Surgical Nursing. Mr. Luciano held positions as a staff nurse, assistant nurse manager, and nurse manager before transitioning to nursing education and school nursing. Before becoming a nurse, his professional experience was in public health with a focus on adolescent health, HIV/AIDS prevention, and school-based clinics. Oswaldo received a BA in Community Health Education and Spanish and a MS in Health Services Management and Policy. He is currently pursuing his PhD in Nursing Education at Nova Southeastern University.
